Transfer by SHUTTLE to the hotel: Hotel Mediodía *** Plaza de Atocha (Plaza Emperador Carlos V) Room distribution.</p> <p>We'll meet at the hotel reception for the walk through the old town of Madrid. Plaza Mayor, Palacio Real, Templo Debod, Gran Vía. Free time to eat and return to the hotel. Day 02.00	Sunday	10.00 h. 20.00 - 23.00 h.	<p>Meeting in front of the Hotel to walk to the Rastro de Madrid (open air flea market), one of the largest and oldest in Europe.</p> <p>Walk to CASAPATAS, one of the best live Flamenco shows in Spain. It is located in the most flamenco district of Madrid, the neighborhood of Lavapiés, in a late nineteenth century building. Here we will have dinner here before the show. On the menu will be typical Spanish dishes such as Iberian ham, sausages and national cheeses, oxtail, among other things.</p> <p>Followed by a stroll through the nightlife of Madrid..</p>

Departure to Cuenca will be by private bus which will leave from in front of Hotel Mediodía (Auditorium Parking lot).</p> <p>Arrival in Cuenca:</p> <p>The host families will be waiting for us at Moralejos Park. Next will be a short introduction to the course, a presentation and the placement of students with their respective host families.</p> <p>Time to ask questions and get to know the families. Guided tour through the Casco Antiguo (old town) of Cuenca, declared a World Heritage Site in 1996. Cuenca was built by the Arabs in the VIII century. History, Architecture and geographical characteristics.</p> <p>We will walk along the Huécar gorge to the castle and descend through its narrow streets to the Plaza Mayor, solving a treasure hunt in small groups.</p>

We will be accompanied by specialized monitors and we will receive the necessary equipment. Part of the mountain range has been protected since 2007 with the name of the Serranía de Cuenca national park.</p> <p>We'll meet at the frontdoor of the academy in order to go together to dinner on the terrace of the Hotel Alfonso VIII, overlooking the entire city. (Tapas also typical of the region of Castilla - La Mancha).</p>	 
	Thursday	09.00 h. 11.15 h.	<p>Departure from Moralejos Park by private coach to Toledo.</p> <p>Arrival in Toledo and transfer to the school. Toledo is known as the City of Three Cultures, due to the coexistence of Christians, Muslims and Jews for centuries. It offers a spectacular sample of the history of Spanish art, which is why it was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1986.</p>	

		14,30 – 16.30 h.	Lunch break Initial orientation guided tour of Toledo to learn about its history, facts and figures and useful things for your stay in the city.
